

Confirm Hazard Management Responsibilities for Planned Operations

Owner: Hazards related to the overall 'design' of the planned operations and worksite.

Prime Contractors: Hazards related to the coordinating of activities at multi-employer worksites.

Employers: Hazards related to equipment, personnel and associated plans, practices & procedures.

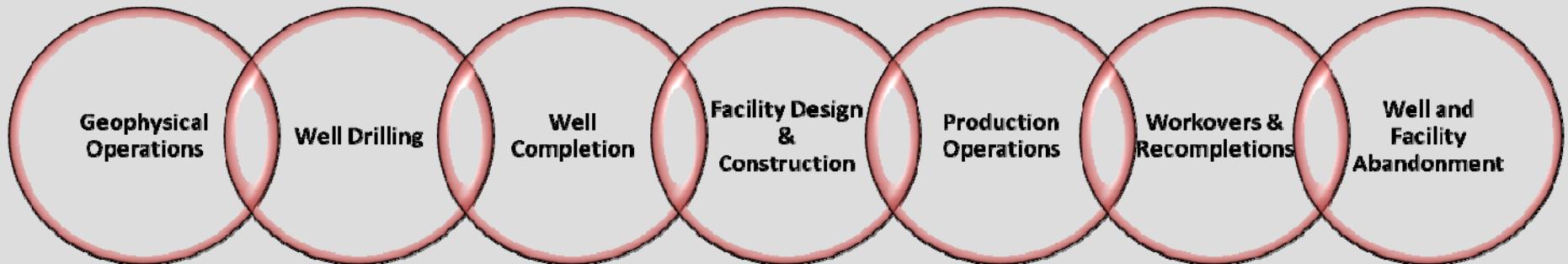


Assess and Address Process, Project and Personal Safety Hazards

If required, conduct a safety review of the overall process and or activity to identify potential safety hazards at design and planning stages. The objective is to ensure hazard management moves beyond field-level / job task assessments. This includes identifying and addressing relevant design codes and manufacturer specifications.



Identify and Address Related OHS Code Requirements



In order of priority:

- Identify and address any applicable sector-specific requirements as detailed in Part 37 of the Code.
- Review Parts 1-29 of the Code. Identify and address any applicable requirements.
- Identify and address any applicable industry specific requirements (Parts 30 to 41).
